Conducting a Survey in Your Local Church

You can conduct a survey to discover the attitudes and behavior in your local church, district or field. Included here is a master copy of the survey questionnaire that you can reproduce and distribute. It was created by the Center for Creative Ministry and can be adapted to fit the needs of your local church.

One of the key issues in conducting a local survey: Will we get enough responses to have statistically valid results? As a general guideline, you should try to have a number of completed questionnaires equal to about half or more of the average attendance on the Sabbaths when you distributed the questionnaires. In other words, if the average attendance was 100 on the two or three Sabbaths that the questionnaires were handed out and collected, then you need to get at least 50 filled-out questionnaires back to have valid survey results.

How to get a good response: Hand out the questionnaires on at least two Sabbaths, because on any given Sabbath a number of regular attenders will not be present. Ask everyone to fill out the questionnaire, whether or not they are members of this congregation or visitors, or even non-Adventists. Generally, a few children under 16 years of age will be able to answer the questions, but don't make any arbitrary cut-off in age.

While the questionnaires are distributed, the pastor or someone should make a brief announcement asking everyone to fill out the questionnaire. On the second and additional Sabbaths, they should remind those who filled it out last week to "not vote twice." Assign deacons or ushers to collect the questionnaires from people after the service, as people are leaving.

How to process the numbers: A worksheet is included here that you can photocopy and use to count and calculate the responses on the questionnaires. This can be a lot of work if it is done by hand. Contact your conference stewardship director for additional help.
